

NEW ZEALAND KIN

Your New Zealand kin originate from Robert Fitzmaurice Gordon (A 0303) and his younger brother Thomas Goodman (A 0304), who emigrated from Ireland in 1863. A third brother, Walter Hussey Fitton (A 0307), who also emigrated, has no known issue in New Zealand, so is not mentioned in this Annexure.

GENERATION 2.**Issue of Robert Fitzmaurice Gordon Sandes (A 0303) and Catherine Peed:**

Bessie Henrietta (Birdie) (0201) was born on 18 March 1868. On 27 April 1904 she was married to Henry Upton, by whom she had issue.

Nellie Kathleen (0202) was born on 1 November 1869. On 11 October 1893 she was married to Ernest de Courcy Drury of Hamilton, by whom she had a son Cecil, a lawyer of Ashburton, and a daughter Joan.

Alice Mary Helena (0203) was born on 4 January 1872. On 17 January 1899 she was married to John Gwalter Palairret of Gisborne, by whom she had issue. She was still living in 1951.

Inez Browning (0204) was born on 12 December 1879.

Athol Gordon (0205) was born on 21 May 1883, but died in April 1887.

Issue of Thomas Goodman Sandes (A 0304) and Isabella McGlashan:

Walter Goodman McEwen (0206) was born at Hamilton, Waikato, on 17 November 1879. He was an engineer, first at sea and then for many years at the Napier Hospital. On 2 November 1914 he married Elizabeth O'Neil, by whom he had four daughters. He died at Napier on 21 September 1954.

Innes Gordon (0207) was born at Hamilton, Waikato, on 4 September 1881, but died of

convulsions and teething on 3 August 1882.

Spencer Fitton (0208) was born at Hamilton on 22 August 1883, and became a chemist in that town. On 2 September 1913, at Dunedin, he married Annie Esther Tansey, by whom he had two daughters. He died on 18 November 1918, from pneumonic influenza.

Stanley Irwin (0209) was born at Hamilton on 7 September 1885, but died of brain concussion from a slight fall on 29 July 1887.

Bessie Kathleen (0210) was born at Hamilton on 22 July 1888. She died unmarried about 1968.

Noel McGlashan (0211) was born at Hamilton on 4 January 1893, and on 15 March 1922, at Lawrence, married Ella Marian Lockhart, by whom he had a daughter. He was an accountant and was also a partner of his brother Tom as an orchardist in Roxburgh. He died at Gore on 22 October 1958.

Tom Trevor (0212) was born at Hamilton on 2 November 1894, and educated at Otago. He began work as a clerk in the Bank of New Zealand and joined up at 19 in the Army, fighting at Gallipoli and on the Somme, where he was wounded and evacuated to England. He spent just over 4 years in the Army, then ran an orchard business in Central Otago with Noel, but when it suffered severe frost damage he moved to Dunedin in 1945. On 24 August 1922 at Masterton he married Margaret Morrison Young, by whom he had two children. He died on 3 January 1947 due to the rigours of military service, and his widow on 8 June 1958.

GENERATION 1.

Issue of Walter Goodman Sandes (0206) and Elizabeth O'Neil:

Ella McGlashan (0101) was born on 26 June 1916. She trained in Dunedin as a physiotherapist, and in WW II served in a hospital ship and as matron of a military hospital in Scotland. In 1943 she visited her cousin Elsie Sandes in Weymouth. In 2001 she was living in Napier.

Noelyne Nancy (0102) was born on 25 December 1920 and was married to a Mr Rapley. In 1999 she was living in Queensland, Australia.

Joan Margaret (0103) was married to a Mr Frost, and died in the late 20th century.

Isla, or Ilsa, Goodman (0104) was married to a Mr Metson, or Metsow, and in 1999 was living with her husband in Napier.

Issue of Spencer Fitton Sandes (0208) and Annie Esther Tansey:

Issue of Noel McGlashan Sandes (0211) and Ella Marian Lockhart:

Shirley Elizabeth (0105) was born on 12 February 1924. In 1948 she was married to William Wards by whom she had two sons and a daughter. Her husband was born on 29 September 1919 and died on 17 September 1990. In 2002 she was living in Dunedin.

Issue of Tom Trevor Sandes (0212) and Margaret Morrison Young:

Louis George (0106) was born at Roxburgh on 2 August 1924, and educated at Roxburgh. He then worked for the Government Audit Office in Wellington before joining the Royal New Zealand Navy at the age of 18, and after service in World War II worked in HM Customs. He later ran a very successful trucking business in Palmerston North. In 1948 he married Dorothy Boyd by whom he has four children. He retired to Palmerston North.

Trevor Goodman (0107) was born at Roxburgh on 21 October 1927, and was educated there and at Otago. He worked first in warehousing and sales in Dunedin, then moved to Hamilton selling steel and to Auckland as manager of a large company in heavy road haulage and aviation. While a sales representative he went into partnership with the Dave Holster, the senior engineer of a heavy engineering company at Tokoroa, a small town north of Taupo. They bought the company, of which Trevor remained chairman though he retired in 1986. In 1954 he married Melva Joy King, by whom he has two children, but she died in a car accident in 1962. In 1965 he married Margaret Stott (nee Friedlander), but they divorced in 1978. On 5 January 1981 he married Gweneth Anne Levet (nee Wolfenden), a widowed teacher of Auckland. Trevor and Gwen used to farm kiwi fruit, flowers and vegetables for market, and are famous for their hospitality, which they extended to us in 2002, at Tauranga and their holiday home at Taupo. Gwen played golf for New Zealand, winning the Fiji Open in 1974, and Trevor was Captain and President of the local golf club. They now live at 25 Contour Ave, Tauranga.
